2026 Charges for Optional Activities

The below charges throughout the year are for optional activities that are part of an education program which voluntary contributions do not cover. The costs listed below are the **maximum** per student and will not exceed this amount. Excursions and Incursions are optional extras and if no payment is received, the student will not attend and an alternative educational activity will be provided.

Optional Activities	Max Cost per Student
Excursions/Incursions: The School Board recognises the value of excursions / incursions for students and seeks to support teachers who co-ordinate them as part of teaching programs.	K - \$50.00 P to 6 - \$120.00
In-term Swimming Lessons: Years PP to 6 students will participate in In-term Swimming Lessons (9-10 days). Although lessons are free, students must pay for the cost of transport and entry to the pool.	\$80.00
School Photos: Parents have a choice of packages. Orders direct to school photo provider.	\$65.00
Inter-School Competitions: Some students may be given the opportunity to participate in interschool Competitions. This charge is to cover travel and event costs.	\$30.00
Graduation: Year 6 student graduation will incorporate a casual end of year function if not covered by fundraising.	\$100.00
Camp for Year 6: A camp is arranged annually for Year 6 students. The charges will include transport, food and activities.	\$500.00
Scholastic Book Club: Approximately 4 opportunities per year to order books.	Optional
Scholastic Bookfair: Approximately 2 opportunities per year to order books.	Optional
Speech Pathology: Assessment screening	\$900.00
PEAC Program: for identified students only.	\$60-\$300 per year
